

Union Hospital Emergency Response Level Is Activated

Union Hospital has raised the response level from “serious” to “emergency” in response to the confirmed case of the Swine Influenza A (H1N1 flu) found in Hong Kong. Infection control measures have been effective in the hospital:

- All hospital staff, visitors and patients should wear surgical masks when entering hospital premises
- All hospital staff, visitors and patients should follow hand hygiene policies
- People with positive temperature are requested to receive further examination at Union Emergency Medicine Centre
