

INFECTIOUS DISEASES AND VACCINES IN CHILDREN

DISEASES	CONSEQUENCES	VACCINATIONS
Diphtheria	Can cause swollen laryngopharynx, fever, respiratory difficulty and heart failure	DTP Vaccine
Tetanus	Can cause muscle cramps and spasm, and even death	
Pertussis	Can cause prolonged cough, pneumonia and brain damage	
Poliomyelitis	Can cause damage of the nervous system leading to paralysis and death	Polio Vaccine
Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)	Can cause meningitis, osteomyelitis, pneumonia, etc.	Hib Vaccine
Hepatitis B	Can cause hepatitis and liver cancer	Hepatitis B Vaccine
Rotavirus	Can cause fever, vomiting and severe diarrhea, leading to dehydration and increasing the risk of major organ failure	Rotavirus Vaccine
Pneumococcus (Streptococcus Pneumoniae)	Can cause bacterial pneumonia, meningitis; bacteremia, cellulitis, osteomyelitis and arthritis	Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine
Rubella	Can lead to complications such as arthritis, thrombocytopenia or encephalitis	MMR Vaccine
Measles	Can cause meningitis or encephalitis, etc.	
Mumps	Can cause meningitis, and infertility if infected at adolescent age	
Chickenpox	Erythema and blisters appear on the body and might form permanent scar	Chickenpox Vaccine
Hepatitis A	Can cause inflammation of the liver cells, leading to liver damage	Hepatitis A Vaccine
Meningococcal	Can lead to septicaemia and bacterial meningitis	Meningococcal A, C, W and Y Vaccine

Japanese Encephalitis	Can cause epilepsy, neurological damage, cognitive or physical disability	Japanese Encephalitis Virus Vaccine
