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Message from the Chief Hospital Manager

Dear Colleagues,

While on the topic of 'innovation', I should not fail to mention the establishment of our Emergency Medicine Centre (EMC) about seventeen years ago. This was certainly an innovative idea for a private hospital. Professor Lo Chung Mau, Secretary for Health during his last visit on March 28 was amazed to learn that we have been running a fully fledged emergency room service for years, 24 hours a day and 365 days a year, with no stoppage. Initially, we started with two Emergency Medicine Specialists, Dr Clara Wu and Dr Yau Fong Chi, leading a number of medical officers who only had general practitioner training. The situation was certainly not ideal when it came to having a cardiac arrest at the hospital doorstep. In order to gain the trust and confidence of the patients we served, a team of well-trained emergency room specialist doctors and nurses have been enlisted and ER (Emergency Room) equipment such as Lucas Chest Compressor and Glide-scope to facilitate intubation were installed. Eventually, our ER service was accredited by the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine and officially recognized by the Department of Health. Union Hospital is the only private hospital in Hong Kong with such achievements. Our ER service now boasts a team of 19 EM specialist physicians, mostly being full-time. In the year 2024, they treated or managed 76,242 patients. This figure compares well with the total attendance of 166,509 patients managed by the ER of Prince of Wales Hospital. Thus, we consider our EMC an integral member of the New Territories East Cluster of Hospitals!

At the turn of the present millennium, i.e., year 2000, we began to develop an electronic system for use by doctors and nurses in management of their patients in the wards and in various outpatient departments and satellite clinics. This is our CMP or 'Clinical Management Programme'. When fully implemented, it should be able to render Union Hospital a 'paperless hospital'! The most important function of the CMP is e-prescription, through which doctors' orders in prescribing will go directly to the Pharmacy with every detail for patient identification so that there will not be any problem with 'transcription error'. This is another big step forward in patient safety. The difficulty is implementation and compliance because doctors always find it easier to write on their progress notes rather than type it out on the computer or iPad keyboard. One of these days, I may have to resort to Donald Trump's tricks by writing out 'administration orders'!

In order to entice visiting doctors to adopt e-prescription and e-progress notes, they are being given remote access to real-time information of their patients in the hospital. This latter includes data on vital signs, updated laboratory results, and medical imaging reports. On discharge, the programme will be able to generate a discharge summary automatically after the attending doctor has completed the final diagnosis and typed in the discharge medications. With all the above available information, the CMP will be able to feed them into templates of claim forms from a variety of insurance companies. The doctor will get those required by the patient with a touch of his/her finger on the keyboard ready for the patient in the majority of cases! Presently our Information Technology Department is working on a smartphone version of the CMP for convenience of the doctors. At the same time, a PDF format of the discharge summary is being developed to facilitate upload of patients' information onto the eHRSS programme with their consent. I believe that this is a prototype of Al!

Lastly, I would like to remind our readers to make time to attend one of our major 30th Anniversary celebratory events, which is a medical symposium on June 22 2025 (Sunday) to be held at the Henderson, the new iconic landmark in Central. You should be attracted by the exciting programme covering frontier advances in medicine to be delivered by a star-studded panel of distinguished academics and researchers in various fields of medicine. I look forward to seeing you at the conference. So it is goodbye for now,

A Collaborative Approach with Parents and Caregivers

Case Example: Comprehensive Care for ADHD in a Primary School Student

Sheldon, a 9-year-old boy who came to our service as his teachers reported that he was having difficulty focusing in class and was often disruptive. His parents were struggling to manage his behaviour at home as well.

After a thorough assessment by our team, Sheldon was diagnosed with Attention-Deficit / Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). Our psychiatrist evaluated his need for medication and started him on a low-dose stimulant, while our clinical psychologist began working with him on behavioural strategies to improve his focus and self-control. Meanwhile, our counselling psychologist provided support to Sheldon's parents, equipping them with strategies to manage his behaviour positively and effectively at home.

Over time, John showed significant improvement both at school and at home. His teachers noted better concentration and participation in class, while his parents reported a more harmonious home environment.

At Union Hospital, our mission is to offer effective, compassionate, and comprehensive mental health care for all ages. Our team consists of experienced professionals including psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, counselling psychologists, and speech therapists. Each team member brings a unique set of skills and expertise, ensuring comprehensive care and support for our patients. Together, we work in synergy, combining our diverse skills to provide the best possible outcomes for our patients, whether they are dealing with the challenges of growing up, navigating the complexities of adult life, or managing the transitions of older age.

The Roche cobas® pro platform is engineered for mid- to high-volume clinical chemistry and immunochemistry testing. This intelligent system delivers a streamlined workflow and short turnaround times, which are critical in today's fast-paced healthcare environment. Key features of this platform include:



- Intelligent Sample Routing: This feature minimizes manual intervention, enhancing both efficiency and accuracy
 in sample processing.
