

Dental Procedure Information

Laminate Veneer

Introduction

Laminate veneer is a technique that involves bonding of a veneer onto the tooth surface by composite resin. It requires just very little removal of tooth structure.

Application: Front teeth - the outer surface

Material: Porcelain

Outcomes

The purpose of this procedure is to improve the aesthetics of teeth, such as shape, size and colour. Also, it can close up the space between teeth and cover the discoloured teeth.

Procedures

- 1. A thin layer of tooth substance is removed from the facial surface of the tooth
- 2. Impressions of the upper and lower teeth are taken and the bite registration is recorded
- 3. The veneer is fabricated in the dental laboratory
- 4. Tooth surface is cleaned before bonding the veneer
- 5. Tooth surface is etched and treated with diluted acid such as 30% phosphoric acid
- 6. The veneer is bonded onto the tooth

Pre-procedure Preparations


The doctor will explain the reason, the procedure and the possible complications to you.

Points to note after restoring with Veneer

- 1. Please do not use veneer to bite hard food.
- 2. The veneer may dislodge or even crack and it may need to be replaced after using a period of time.
- 3. You may experience some sensitivity after make the veneer. It is due to irritation to the pulp during the preparation. However, if the sensitivity persists or condition worsens, please contact the dentist for further examination.
- 4. Please keep the teeth clean and visit the dentist regularly.
