PRE-NATAL

NURTURING MATERNITY

This ritual is then completed with a mini facial using guasha to leave the expectant or new mother feeling refreshed and rejuvenated overall.

POST-NATAL

Our Post-Natal Massage helps new mothers get on a speedy road to recovery. This full body massage uses lymphatic drainage techniques to slim, purify and tone the body. For deep relaxation, a homemade aromatic poultice of lavender and rose is applied to the back and abdomen, drawing out lingering fatigue and tension.
